

Geneva Baseball Association offers a Colt League program for high school kids who love the game of baseball and want to continue playing the game. Players' ages: 15, 16 and 17 are eligible to participate.

The Colt League begins shortly after school gets out so as not to interfere with the High School season. Kids playing on any of the High School teams are eligible to play in the Colt League. Players not trying out or making the High School team are also encouraged to sign up for our Colt league teams. The teams are coached by volunteer parents and we participate in the "Tri-City Colt Baseball League". Area teams involved in this league in the past include: Wasco, Burlington, Oswego, St. Charles, Batavia, Elburn, Dekalb, Yorkville, North Aurora and Plano. The season runs approximately from June 1st through July 30th. Games are played Monday through Friday (leaving the weekends open for tournaments, if desired) Practices will begin towards the end of May.

- Colt League play will start in early June. Colt registration will close in early May - all players need to be registered and paid in full before the first practice.
- Players age: 15, 16, 17 are eligible to participate
- Colt teams will play between 15 - 22 games.
- The Colt League will play teams from other towns: The boundaries are roughly; I55 to the South, I47 to the West, I90 to the North and I355 to the East (i.e. St. Charles, Batavia, Wasco, Aurora, Plano, Oswego, Elburn, Dekalb etc)
- Colt Home games are played on the Geneva High School Sophomore field.
